Project based learning	Industry provide students with a workplace problem or scenario. Students work on the project
	over an extended period of time.
□ Tours or Site Visits	Employers host students for a tour or their organization so students can learn more about the business, the pathways and the skills required
Traineeship / Apprenticeship	Employment of a student on a school-based traineeship or apprenticeship
Connect to Industry (guest speaker)	Industry experts present, in person or virtually, information about their career, their typical workday, and the knowledge skills and attributes required to pursue and be successful in their work. Students have opportunities to talk and ask questions of the professional.
□ Flexible Industry Pathway Co- design	Employers/Industry provide input into the design of a Flexible Industry Pathway program to ensure it meets industry needs and provides a pipeline of skilled young people to local industry.
□ Mock Interview Program	Conducting mock interviews with students. Applicants are required to prepare an application letter and resume before the interview and are encouraged to dress appropriately for the interview.
Professional Development for Teachers	Hosting a teacher for an unpaid work placement so they can gain a better understanding of your workplace and the skills required
□ Job Shadow	Students "shadow" professionals during a normal work day to gain a firsthand look at the skills, knowledge and education required to succeed in a career.
Career Information	Supplying information about career pathways and opportunities within your industry
Career Story Board	Students interview employers /staff about their career journey and prepare a career story board
Mentor	One on one relationship between students and employee to assist in career exploration and job readiness
Curriculum Enrichment Activities	Employer participates in activities in classroom or at employer site to enhance regular curriculum (eg chef assists with a cooking class)
U Workplace Learning	A registry of businesses willing to host work experience. Applicants will be required to apply for the work experience placement.
